

ART CONTEST



Send a message to Lee County citizens by producing a full-color drawing or painting on the theme of "Leave The Scene Clean." Students will visualize a correct environmental action and transfer that mental picture into a work of art. Possible ways of expanding on this theme could include: litter prevention, clean-up campaigns, beautification efforts such as landscaping and tree planting, protecting the environment, and recycling.

WHO CAN ENTER: Lee County students grades K-12.

RULES:

- 1. Deadline for entries is **January 31, 2024** (Winners will be announced by mid-February)
- 2. Each entry MUST HAVE completed Entry Form TAPED ONLY to back side.
- 3. Only **ORIGINAL** artwork with **ORIGINAL CONTENT** will be accepted.
- 4. Artwork should be in full color. **NO WHITE SPACE**
- 5. **HORIZONTAL** formats only. Single sheet of 8.5" X 11" paper only
- 6. Students may use any 2D medium (i.e., crayons, watercolors, pastels, color pencils, etc.).
- 7. No more than 2 entries per person.
- 8. No 3-dimensional (sculpture, bas relief) entries.

JUDGING: Special volunteer committee of KLCB.

- Artwork **MUST** have an **ENVIRONMENTAL MESSAGE** to be considered.
- Entries will be judged on creativity, originality and focus on the message.
- Four overall winners and three honorable mentions will be chosen from each of these grade groups:

K - 3

4 - 6

7 - 9

10 - 12

WHAT DO ARTISTS WIN?:

The four overall winning illustrations will be enlarged and appear on the side of a Lee County Waste Pro truck and printed on reusable tote bags. The overall winning and honorable mention artwork will be on public display during April 2024 in honor of Earth month. All winners will also receive a certificate and prize pack.

*Artwork, except 1st Place and Honorable Mentions, will be returned or made available for pick up after winner notification. Any artwork not picked up will be discarded after June 1st.
